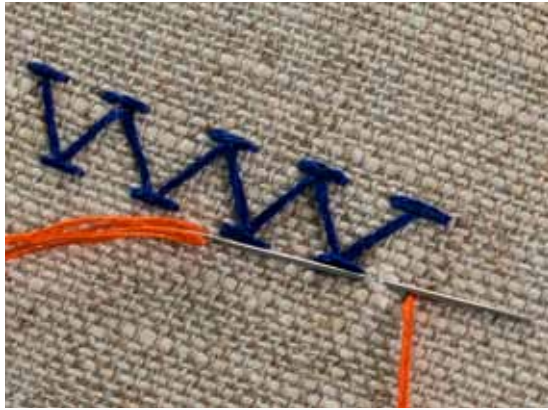


Double (woven) chevron stitch

LEFT-HANDED



1 Work a foundation row of chevron stitch first (see the separate tutorial for this). Then change to a coordinating or contrasting thread to begin the second row, right to left.



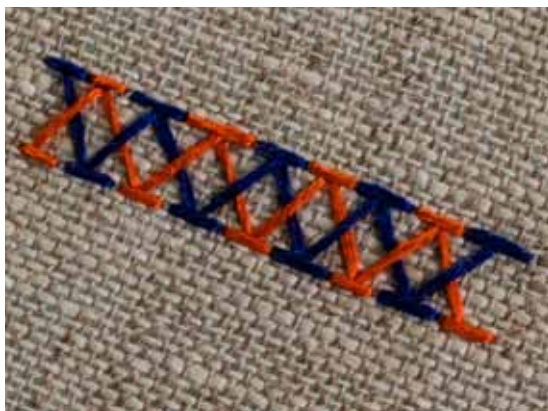
2 Form the small stitch at the opposite side of the line directly below (or above) the first small stitch. Then pass the needle under, not through, the first slanting stitch.



3 Sew the next small stitch between the short stitches of the foundation row. You are sewing two interwoven rows of chevron stitch in one line.



4 Then go down over the foundation row for the second slanting stitch and make another small stitch between the next two of the foundation row.



5 Continue alternating the slanting stitches under and over the foundation slanting stitches in turn to complete this highly decorative border stitch.



6 The reverse side shows the pairs of small stitches in the two colours. You could also work chevron or double chevron stitch over braid or ribbon for another look.
